Steeped in 160 years of rich history we pride ourselves on providing a quality Catholic education that enables all members of the school community to thrive. The first parish school of St Peter's, Bentleigh East, was established in 1865 and was housed in a tiny timber schoolhouse.

Today St Peter's provides exceptional contemporary facilities, providing the opportunity for students to engage in a comprehensive curriculum and participate in learning that empowers them to question, critique, take risks and understand our ever changing world.

Learning

At St Peter's Primary, we are committed to meeting the diverse learning needs of every student through targeted literacy and numeracy programs, including intervention and extension opportunities.

Our approach is guided by the latest research in the science of learning, with a strong foundation in phonics-based literacy development.

Beyond the core curriculum, students engage in a rich specialist program, including Visual Arts, Performing Arts, Japanese, Physical Education, and Digital Technology, enhancing their learning experience.

Technology supports student learning, with one-to-one Chromebooks for Years 3–6 and shared Chromebooks and iPads for younger students. We are proud to offer an inclusive education that supports and celebrates students with diverse learning needs, ensuring every child is empowered to reach their full potential.



Community

We value the strong partnerships between our school, families, and the wider community. Our thriving parent network, led by an active Parents and Friends Association, fosters connection through community events and fundraising initiatives.

Families stay engaged with school life through our fortnightly newsletter, keeping everyone informed and involved.

We are passionate about making a difference, with social justice initiatives supporting local, national and international organisations.

Our Intergenerational Program with Warrawee Aged Care Facility builds meaningful connections across generations, while visits to local kindergartens and early learning centres create special moments of storytelling, play, and creativity.

Together, we build a supportive and connected school community where everyone belongs.



Faith

St Peter's is a vibrant and welcoming Catholic community where faith is at the heart of everything we do. Our students are encouraged to live out the Gospel values daily, with the question "What would Jesus do?" guiding their thoughts, words, and actions.

Values such as kindness, forgiveness, love, respect, dignity and compassion are embedded in our learning. These principles empower our students to make thoughtful choices and leave St Peter's as responsible, caring citizens of the world.

Each day begins with Christian meditation and prayer, offering a moment of stillness and reflection. This practice helps our students center themselves and prepare their minds for the day ahead.

Through the exploration of biblical narratives, participating in liturgies and Masses and preparing for the sacraments, our students deepen their understanding of Jesus and discover how His teachings connect to their lives today.

Students can receive private tuition in violin, guitar, ukulele, keyboard, flute, singing, percussion and more.

Private tuition is offered in performance, song & dance and production.

- Lunchtime Clubs to engage students who don't always enjoy physical activity.
